

Autumn Leaves Scenic Tour

Regulations



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ORGANISATION

- 1. The Historic Rally Car Register will organise the 17th "Autumn Leaves Scenic Tour", a Touring Assembly on Saturday 2nd November 2019.
- 2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport U/K (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations. A certificate of exemption (Permit no 114774 has been issued by the Motor Sports U/K.

ELIGIBILITY

- 3. The event is open to four-wheeled road cars first registered before 1st January 1999. Interesting later cars may be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
- 4. All cars must be taxed, hold a V5C Registration Document and where appropriate have a valid MOT certificate. Cars must not display any advertising or carry any competition numbers on the doors.
- 5. Any person may enter the event.
- 6. All drivers must produce a valid driving license for the car being driven.

ENTRIES

7. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close finally on Tuesday 29th October. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of £95 for two people travelling in the car. Please add £30 for each additional person. Each entry will be acknowledged. Where possible all correspondence will be via e mail.

It is therefore important that your e mail details is entered clearly on the entry form.

Please make any cheque payable to HRCR. Final Instructions (including an Entry List and directions to the Start) will be sent out during the week prior to the event.

- 8. The entry fee includes a full colour Road book, one rigid participating vehicle plate, Breakfast roll, Morning Lunch. Afternoon Tea and a 3 course early evening meal with a commemorative award.

- 10. The maximum number of cars on the event is sixty. The minimum is twenty. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full. Entries will be selected in order of receipt, the running order being decided by the organisers. If an entrant particularly wants to run close to a friend/colleague, then this should be noted in the appropriate space on the entry form.

<u>ROUTE</u>

11. The start venue is the Hogs Head Pub, Great Treadam, Llatillio Crosseny, Abergavenny. NP78TA. www.hogsheadpub.co.uk The finish venue is the Forest Hills Golf Club, Mile End Road, Coleford, Glos, GL16 7QD. www.foresthillsgolfandleisure.co.uk Tel: 01594 810620

The route will cover approximately 120 miles in the Monmouthshire, Black Mountains, and the Royal Forest of Dean.

- 12. The route will be split into three sections as defined in an easy to follow full colour Tulip style Road Book issued to entrants at the start of the event. Although not required to complete the route, entrants may like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' maps 161, 149, & 162.
- 13. The first car will leave the start at 10.01. The others will leave at one minute intervals for road safety reasons. There will be a course closing car who will be travelling the entire route.
- 14. Along the route, there will be Check Points and Code Boards to observe the entrant's adherence to the defined route. At each Check Point the entrant's Route Check Card will be signed. These

Check Points will have plenty of time to be visited. The code boards will be placed along the route. These are used for participant's route verification purposes only.

DOCUMENTATION

 16. Cars and Entrants must arrive at the start no later than 8:45am. The following documents must be available for inspection: Driving Licence for the driver
V5C Registration Certificate for the car being used Current vehicle **MOT Certificate** (if required) for the car being used

- 17. It is the entrants' responsibility to ensure that their vehicle is taxed and insured, you will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at documentation.
- 18. Any vehicle which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start.
- 19. After documentation, entrants will be given their Vehicle Identity Plate with cable ties, Road Book, Route Check Card and Food vouchers.

- 23. Entrants will be identified by a vehicle commemorative plate, supplied by the organisers. This must be displayed in an external prominent forward facing position on the vehicle. Cable ties will be supplied.
- 24. All marshals are deemed to be judges of fact.
- 25. As an added attraction to the event, we would ask that people taking part wear "Clothing from the era of the vehicle being used," This is not compulsory but will add to the occasion. There will be a prize for the best attire as decided by the organiser's.
